



## Neighborhood Caucus Resolution

A Resolution To Support Fair and Effective Elections

WHEREAS the delegate and convention system is a grassroots process which selects qualified nominees without regard to wealth or fame; and

WHEREAS discussion and exchange of ideas among neighbors provides the highest quality of voter participation; and

WHEREAS face-to-face conversations between candidates and voters provide more meaningful voter involvement than mass media campaigns comprised of 30-second commercials and sound bites; and

WHEREAS the delegate and convention system has produced the best managed state in the nation;

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Utah County Republican Party that:

- 1) the republican principles embodied in the neighborhood caucus elections and convention system should be defended; and
- 2) the Party should be engaged in educating voters about those principles and the advantages of such a system; and
- 3) we should continue to seek improvements in the process to maximize active participation that is representative of the values of all Republican party members.
