Upon completion of the Organizing Convention business, all **COUNTY DELEGATES** are **CALLED** to report to their credentialed Senate District Caucuses to elect by ballot 22 UCRP Representatives to the Utah Republican Party State Central Committee (SCC) for a two-year term to begin after the May 20 State Convention. The SCC meets quarterly and is the governing body of the State Party. After SCC balloting, meet with your County Elected Officials in your Senate Caucuses. - Attend *Meet the Candidate* events.
- Attend the County Convention to elect County Party leadership.
- Attend your Senate Caucus (after the convention) to vote in SCC elections and hear from your elected officials.
