



## **2024-2026 County Delegate Duties and Responsibilities**

Congratulations on being elected as a County Delegate! Your willingness to participate in the Party and the political process is greatly appreciated. This sheet will hopefully provide a few details of your new responsibilities and what is expected.

First, remember that each County Delegate must be a registered Republican. To be seated the Utah County Republican Party must have on file your name, telephone number, mailing address, and email address. The name you use should be the legal name you use to register to vote. Be aware that as a County Delegate you will periodically receive important communications from the UTGOP, elected officials, and GOP candidates.

### **Terms of Service**

The term of service for all delegates is two years. Should you move or change addresses during that time, **please inform your Precinct Chair.**

### **County Nominating Convention 2024**

For the near future, your biggest responsibility is to attend and participate in the **2024 Utah County Republican Party Convention which will be held on Saturday, April 20, 2024, at Mountain View High School in Orem.** Credentialing usually begins at 8:00 am and you should plan on a full day of attendance. To fully participate, you will need to meet with and vet the candidates.

All County Delegates will be vetting the candidates and voting for the following races: Utah County Commission Seat "C," Utah County Recorder, Utah County Assessor. Some delegates, depending on House District and State School Board District, will also be vetting candidates and voting for the following races: House Rep Districts 57, 58, 61 and State School Board District 13 (all races that are multi-county will be vetted and voted on by State Delegates).

### **Utah County Organizing Convention is in 2025**

You will also need to attend the Utah County Organizing Convention in 2025 where you will vet and elect the County Republican Party's leadership. This is a vitally important election.

It is your responsibility to educate yourself about all the candidates. Expect to receive mailings, phone calls, invitations, emails, etc., from them during their campaign. Please read all the material they send you, and attend Meet the Candidate events and other opportunities to listen to and become acquainted with them.
