OUR NEIGHBORHOOD CAUCUS SYSTEM

We recognize the current political unease and are equally troubled by the global and local turmoil. Yet, we remain hopeful, anchored by our shared values and the fundamental principles of representative government.

This flyer lists our Republican Party nominees, chosen by delegates to best represent our ideals and platform.

Our neighborhood caucus system empowers your voice with representation that provides one delegate for approximately 160 constituents. In comparison, each Utah House member represents more than 46,000 people.

This system allows extensive representation, and all registered Party members can participate and even become delegates. Delegates invest 20 to 40 hours in preparation, engaging deeply with community concerns. Notably, 2024 marked a 72% influx of new delegates in the Utah County Republican Party, including many younger Republicans.

The Neighborhood Caucus System is the purest form of representative government, resistant to the influence of big money that plagues our politics. Join us in promoting grassroots representation and foundational principles!
